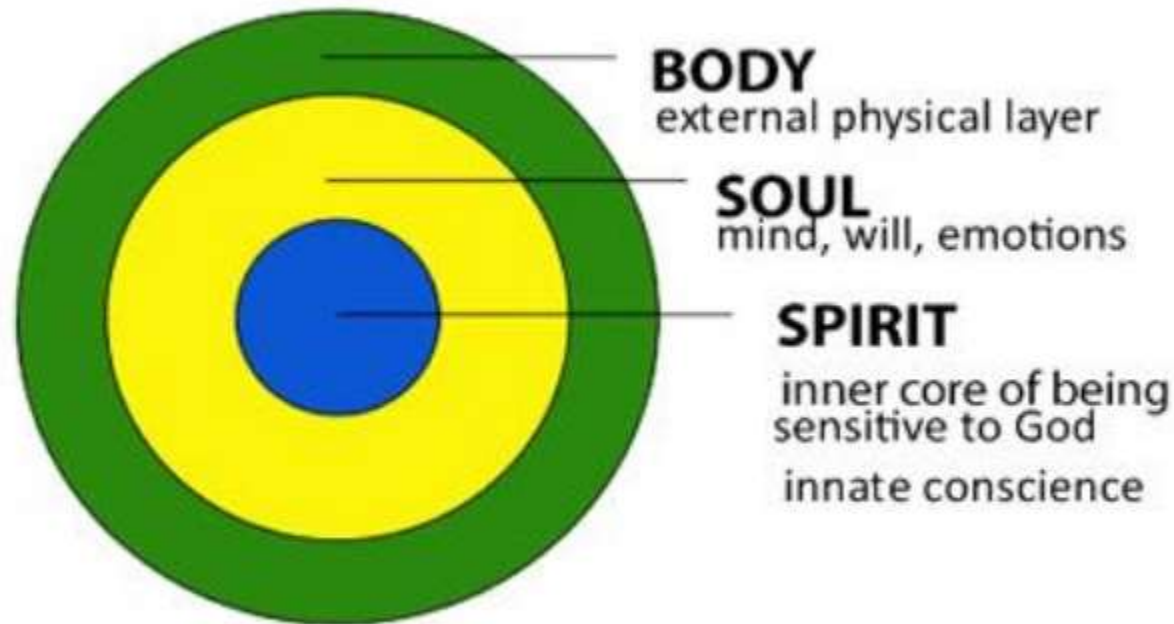
Thrive =

Each of these realms affects the functioning of the other:

If I am physically weak or fatigued it is difficult to worship or keep our emotions steady or push ahead spiritually – The state of my physicality influences the other realms.

If I am weak spiritually it can affect how I govern my emotions and govern my body and my thought life.

If am emotionally unsteady or overwhelmed or there is a stronghold it affects me physically, psychologically and spiritually

As believers the Holy Spirit is endeavouring to work with us and mature each of these areas of our existence so we are like Jesus in the way we think, feel, respond.

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, according to the promise of life which *is* in Christ Jesus, to Timothy, my dearly beloved child. Grace, mercy, peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. I thank God, whom I serve from my forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I remember you in my prayers night and day, greatly desiring to see you, being mindful of your tears, so that I may be filled with joy, taking recollection of the sincere faith that is in you, which first dwelt in your grandmother Lois, and in your mother Eunice. And I am persuaded that it is in you also.

Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God, which is in you by the laying on of my hands.

but of power and of love and of a sound mind

Our job is to never be lacking in zeal – **FAN THE FLAME**

Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but *only* one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may win. Everyone who competes in the games exercises self-control in all things. They then *do it* to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. Therefore I run in such a way, as not without aim; I box in such a way, as not beating the air; but I beat and discipline my body and make it my slave. 1 Corinthians 9:24-27

The crowd rose up together against Paul and Silas, and the chief magistrates tore their robes off them and proceeded to order *them* to be beaten with rods. When they had struck them with many blows, they threw them into prison, commanding the jailer to guard them securely; and he, having received such a command, threw them into the inner prison and fastened their feet in the stocks. But about midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them; and suddenly there came a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison house were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were unfastened. When the jailer awoke and saw the prison doors opened, he drew his sword and was about to kill himself, supposing that the prisoners had escaped. But Paul cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Do not harm yourself, for we are all here!" And he called for lights and rushed in, and trembling with fear he fell down before Paul and Silas, and after he brought them out, he said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" Acts 16:22-30
