



A Revolution of LOVE

He was sexually promiscuous, shows signs of rejection, anger, and excessive shyness.

# Are some, all or none of these things from his past dealt with at the moment of his Salvation?





**Justification** = God's act of removing the guilt and penalty of sin while at the same time declaring a sinner righteous through Christ's atoning sacrifice.

Righteousness from God is viewed as being credited to the sinner's account through faith alone, without works.

Something God does for us based on our repentance and faith - The free will to acknowledge Jesus as the son of God who dies and rose again.

Wrath of God appeased, Debt of sin cancelled, Peace with God, The gift of the Holy Spirit as a seal of this covenant

Happens in an instant the moment God accepts us! Legal term (not Guilty)

**Sanctification** = The act or process of acquiring sanctity, of being made or becoming holy.

Something God does in us as we co-operate with the leading of the Holy Spirit The process of making us Christ Like

A life long journey that depends upon our obedience and submission to the Lordship of Christ

#### **Conclusion of Jesus Ministry**

But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. Therefore He says:

"When He ascended on high, He led captives free and gave gifts to men." Now this, "He ascended" what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)

#### for the work of ministry

for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. Ephesians 4:7-14

Jesus proclaimed to those waiting in Hades His victory over sin/death. This was akin to a Roman Emporers victory procession where the exalted Jesus endows the Church (saints) with the giftedness necessary to continue to accomplish the WORK of MINISTRY which he began back in Luke 4.

### What is the work of ministry?



#### **Start of Jesus Ministry**

Then Jesus came to Nazareth, where he had been raised. As was his custom, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day. When he stood up to read, the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling the scroll, he found the place where it was written,

- The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; he has anointed me to tell the good news to the poor. He has sent me to announce freedom to the prisoners and recovery of sight to the blind, to heal the broken hearted and set at liberty those who are oppressed, and to announce the acceptable year of the Lord's favour.
- Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant, and sat down. While the eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fixed on him, he said to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled, as you've heard it read aloud."

Jesus proclaimed to those in his home town that He was the Messiah prophesied by Isaiah and that they would know He is the one because this list of ministries would identify and qualify his Messiahship.

Wherever you see these thing occurring God is truly at work and this list is the primary template we should use to assess the fullness and effectiveness of our personal and Church ministry.



### Five foundational ministries of Jesus that He wants to do for every person:

#### 1. Salvation:

Preach good news to the poor - Gospel 1 Corinthians 15:1-8

Acceptable year of the Lords favour

God will accept you + You can accept God: Now is the time (Romans 11:25)

#### 2. Spirit Baptism:

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me and has anointed me Every person needs to be anointed by the Holy Spirit (John 1:32-3; 4:2)

#### 3. Physical Healing:

Recovery of sight for the blind

Cure for Physical infirmity - That evening many demon-possessed people were brought to Jesus. He cast out the evil spirits with a simple command, and he healed all the sick –

Matthew 8:16 + Acts 10:37

### Five foundational ministries of Jesus that He wants to do for every person:

#### 4. Deliverance:

Proclaim liberty to the captives

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, and because God was with him, he went around doing good and healing everyone who was oppressed by the Devil. Acts 10:38

#### 5. Soul (Inner) Healing:

Heal the broken hearted συντρίβω (Soon tree bo = Shattered)

Set at liberty those who are oppressed (bruised or crushed)

Emotional or mental strongholds like Rejection = Insecurity, Anger (rage), Pride, Independence, Easily offended, Fear, Shyness + Ioneliness, control + manipulation

What we see is Gods plan to bring about restoration/renewal for the Spirit + Soul (mind and emotions) + body.

If these are the five foundational ministries of Jesus and He has passed the baton on to the Church (saints) to continue, then how well have you been trained to administer these 5 ministries to people?

Salvation/Sharing the Gospel (Basic Truths) Hebrews 6:1-3
Spirit Baptism/Anointing

**Physical Healing** 

Deliverance – Confronting and Evicting the demonic Soul (Inner) Healing - Repairing wounded Hearts and distressed Minds

ΔΙ**ακονία Diakonia** — An official attendant offering the service of relief (from Destiny in Hell, Bondage, Darkness, Deception)

#### What is entailed in Discipling someone?


- Bringing people into a full knowledge of Gods truths
- Ensuring they understand Gods anointing & how to safely and humbly advance the Kingdom through power not just words
- Ensuring they are free from strongholds, evil practices, destructive or crippling patterns of behaviour and thinking that doesn't have them walking in the light of liberty
- Advancing them towards wholeness (not perfection) Spirit, soul and body and teaching them how to think and behave maturely
- Preparing them to pass on the knowledge and practice that they received from you
- How many of us feel that we received a full and proper discipleship training?

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ he is a new creation. Old things have disappeared, and all things have become new! 2 Corinthians 5:17
