Worship is an event or an experience? Or something far greater in scope?


Worship = A product of a lifestyle focused on an ongoing awareness of the constant presence of God


Worship encompasses all that I do, because all that I do, is done in recognition of being for Gods glory.



Worship = Posture

Expectancy - Anticipation - Giving - Receiving - Presenting







In every place of worship, I want men to pray with holy hands lifted up to God, free from anger and controversy.

The postures of worship include standing, kneeling, prostrating ourselves, eyes lifted up, eyes cast down, and hands raised.

This is not legalism as we do not see one specific posture universally required in worship, and neither do we see one specific "authorized" expression of worship.

Multiple Factors at play in worship


Personalities – Outgoing or Reserved Temperaments Musical preferences, Family and life circumstances, Song choice

Present your body as a living sacrifice!

- Drag yourself onto the altar if necessary WARFARE
- Deal with bad attitudes, sin, indifference
- Push through limitations of body and senses to encounter God
- Posture yourself to give and receive CHEERLEADER
- Move outside song selection
- Remember the Holy Spirit is moving infinitely beyond the song
- Stand in it and let Gods presence surround you! SOAKING
