FUNDAMENTALS TO A PIONEER

- Sent by the Father
 - Rely upon His calling and power
- Fear is always answered by faith
 - Solely standing upon His promises and truths
- Carrying a truth larger than themselves
 - No compromise on His word
 - Claiming the impossible as possible
- Kingdom oriented
 - Live to bring glory to God in every way possible
 - Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done
- Remaining teachable and humble

THE ENEMIES OF A PIONEER

- Experience substituting truth
 - When God doesn't move the way you think He will
- False humility
 - Fear driven passivity
- Ambition for survival
 - Self-preservation over the Kingdom
- Pride and Glory
 - Confidence vs. Godfidence
 - Stumbling on your own bravado





WHAT DOES AN APOSTLE LOOKS LIKE?

- Looks ahead to what can be, instead of what is
 - Often found in the gap between this world and the prophetic
- Leads in faith to a destination that they themselves may not have been to
- Uncompromising on God's word
- Zealously pursuing the Kingdom of God
 - In many various forms
